



STRAWS HAVE MANY USES!

I discovered that straws make a good wire channel to keep projects looking neat.

There are two ways to do this.

If your project is completed, you can still make it look neat with straws. Using a hobby knife or scissors, start slicing the straw at one end in a circular motion, like you are peeling an orange, trying to keep the peel in one piece. Wrap the straw around the wires. You may need to tape the ends as this method tends to unravel.

For a new project, slice the straw in small sections, keeping each piece connected, as in the photo above. Pass the wires through as you build the project.
